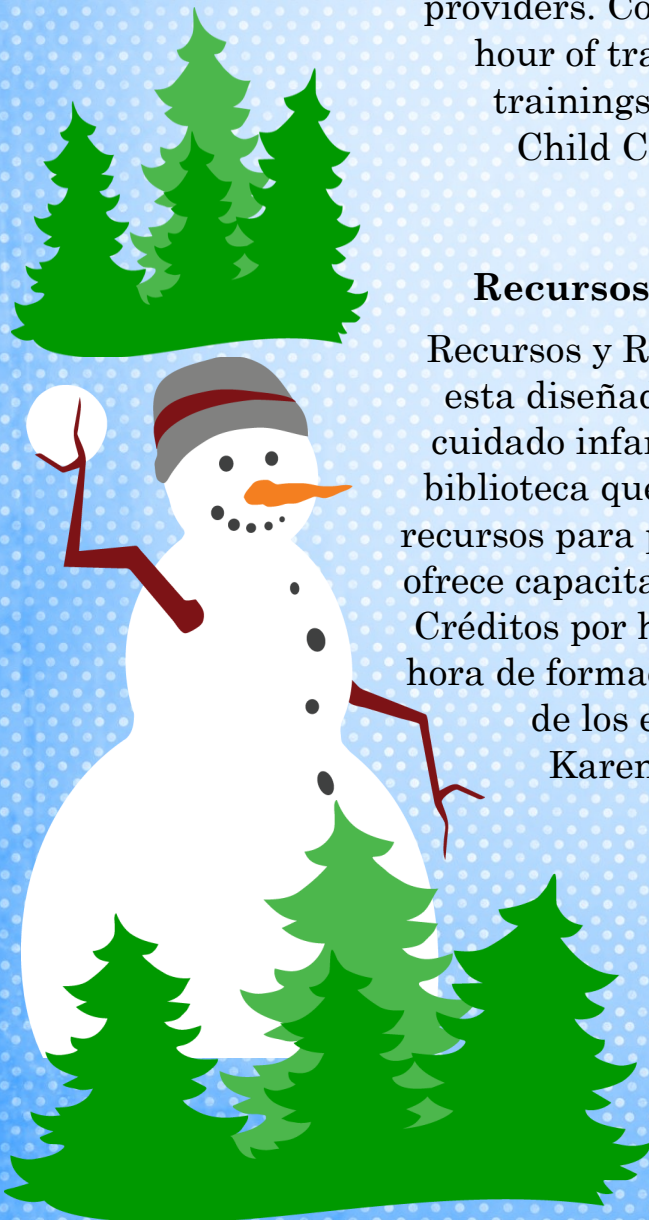
Child Care Resource and Referral

Subsidized Child Care Provider

On behalf of DCDEE & NC FAST Team, we are writing to inform you that we are quickly approaching the timeframe when you will need to complete your annual re-enrollment through the Provider Portal, if you have not done so already or did not initially enroll during 2017. Yearly re-enrollment is required for a provider to continue participating in Subsidized Child Care Assistance (SCCA) and must be completed through the Provider Portal - this is not a new requirement for SCCA, but something you completed through a paper process in prior years.

Re-enrollment must be completed by December 31, 2017 or you will be automatically un-enrolled by NC FAST and will not be able to get paid for children receiving subsidy assistance until you are once again enrolled. If you initially enrolled during 2017, then you will not need to re-enroll until next year.

To re-enroll, log into the Provider Portal and click “Re-enroll” on the Home page under Useful Links (upper right). (Before re-enrolling, we strongly recommend reviewing the *SCCA - Enrollment and Re-enrollment for Providers Job Aid* in the Provider Portal.)

As a reminder, the Provider Help Desk (PHD) is available to assist you with questions about Provider Portal functions, including re-enrollment. The PHD may be reached at 919-813-5460. If you need assistance, please do not wait to contact the PHD.
