Spicy Black Bean Soup

“Warm and hearty soup for a cold winter day.”

Ingredients

- 1 tablespoon of vegetable oil
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 2 carrots, chopped
- 2 teaspoons of chili powder
- 1 teaspoon of ground cumin
- 4 cups of vegetable stock
- 2 (15 ounce) cans of black beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 (8.75 ounce) can of whole kernel corn
- 1/4 teaspoon of ground black pepper
- 1 (14.5 ounce) can of stewed tomatoes

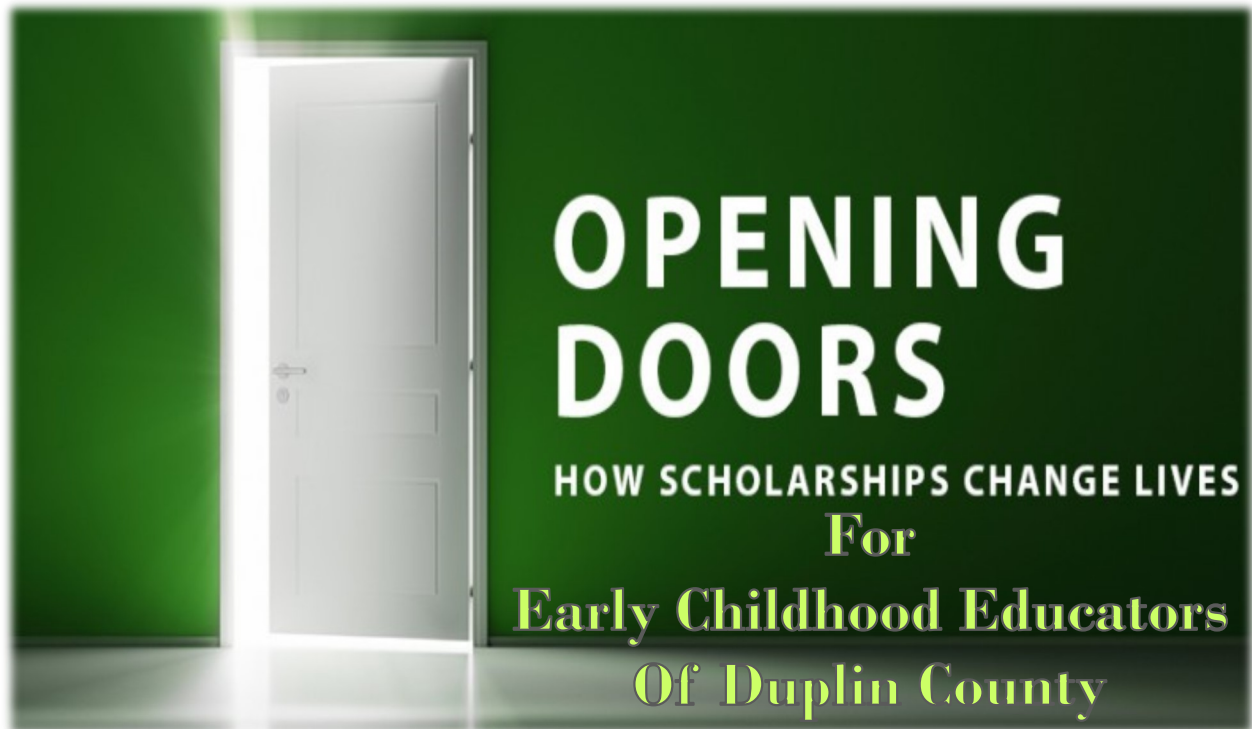


Directions

1. In large saucepan, heat oil over medium heat; cook onion, garlic, and carrots, stirring occasionally, for five minutes or until onion is softened. Add chili powder and cumin; cook, stirring, for 1 minute. Add stock, one can of the beans, corn, and pepper; bring to a boil.
2. Meanwhile, in food processor or blender, puree together tomatoes and remaining can of beans; add to pot. Reduce heat, cover, and simmer for 10-15 minutes or until carrots are tender.
