No-Sew Sock Turkey

It's turkey time! You will love this little project. A no-sew sock turkey craft which will make a wonderful DIY gift or a decoration for your home during fall months. And it's a perfect solution to use up the odd socks we know you have.



Materials

- An odd brown sock fluffy one if possible
- Felt (different colors)
- Wiggly eyes
- Small rubber bands
- Rice
- Scissors
- Hot glue or felt glue

Instructions

- 1. Fill the sock with rice. With fluffy socks we recommend you use another sock to fill and place it inside the fluffy one.
- 2. Tie the sock with a rubber band. Use another rubber band to make the head.
- 3. Cut the tail feathers out of felt. If you are using thicker felt it will be able to keep its form by its own, if you're using thinner felt you might need to reinforce it by gluing a piece of cardboard onto it.



- 4. Glue the feathers together, making a nice tail shape. You can use the glue gun or felt glue.
- 5. Glue the tail to the turkey body with a glue gun.
- 6. Cut a small triangle beak out of felt and glue it onto the head.
- 7. Glue the wiggly eyes on.

Rosemary - Roasted Chicken with Apples and Potatoes

The beginning of fall comes with an abundance of apples, which means it's time to start baking! But more than pies, apples roast extremely well with chicken! This dish makes a fantastic sweater-weather meal, with beautifully roasted chicken and an apple, potato, and onion bake that takes advantage of the delicious roasted chicken drippings.

Ingredients

- Cooking spray
- 2 tablespoons of butter
- 1 large onion, sliced
- Salt plus more to taste
- 4 teaspoons of white sugar
- 5 medium apples peeled, cored, and cut into 1/4 inch slices
- 2 tablespoons of olive oil
- 6 bone-in, skin on chicken thighs
- 2 tablespoons of chopped fresh rosemary
- Ground black peeper to taste

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Spray the top and bottom parts of a broiler pan with cooking spray.
- 2. Melt butter in skillet over medium heat and add onion slices. Sprinkle onions with 1 teaspoon of salt and sauté for 2 minutes. Add sugar and continue cooking until onions are translucent but not browned, 6 to 8 minutes. Remove from heat.
- 3. Layer apples, potatoes, and sautéed onion slices in the bottom part of the broiler pan. Cover with the part top of the broiler pan.
- 4. Drizzle olive oil over chicken thighs. Sprinkle with fresh rosemary, salt, and pepper. Rub olive oil and spices thoroughly all over each thigh and place on the top part of the broiler pan.
- 5. Roast in the preheated oven until juices run clear and instant read the thermometer inserted into the thickest part of the thigh, near the bone, reads 165 degrees; about one hour. Serve apples, potatoes, and onion alongside chicken thighs.

The annual license fee invoices will be mailed November 2, 2020 to licensed child care providers for the current year. Payment to DCDEE must be made online by December 17, 2020. No partial payments will be accepted, and no payment plans will be established.

Fire inspections need to be completed before they expire! Once completed you must send a copy to your DCDEE licensing consultant within seven days.

Failure to do so could result in a violation.
